**HEDIS CPT II CODES:** Reporting quality measures completed for Medicare Advantage *Include reporting measure codes on claims* 

Submitting CPT II Codes will reduce request for medical records

Controlling High Blood Pressure (CBP)*	3074F Most recent systolic blood pressure is < 130mmHg
Systolic	3075F Most recent systolic blood pressure is between 130-139mmHg
,	3077F Most recent systolic blood pressure is ≥ 140mmHg
Diastolic	3078F Most recent diastolic blood pressure is < 80mmHg
	3079F Most recent diastolic blood pressure is between 80-89mmHg
	3080F Most recent diastolic blood pressure is ≥ 90mmHg
Care for Older Adults (COA)	1123F Advance care plan discussed & documented or surrogate decision
Advance Care Planning	maker documented in medical record
	1124F Patient did not wish or unable to name surrogate decision maker
	or provide advance care plan
	1157F Advance care plan legal document present in medical record
	1158F Advanced care planning discussion documented in medical record
Medication Review*	1159F Medication list documented in medical record
	1160F Review of all medications by prescribing practitioner or clinical
	pharmacist and documented in medical record
Functional Assessment	1170F Functional status assessed
Pain Assessment	1125F Pain present, severity quantif ed
	1126F No pain present, severity quantif ed
Comprehensive Diabetes Care (CDC)	3044F Most recent HbA1c is < 7.0%
Hemoglobin A1c Screening (HbA1c)	3045F Most recent HbA1c is between 7.0%-9.0%
	3046F Most recent HbA1c is ≥ 9.0%
Attention for Nephropathy	3060F Positive microalbuminuria test reviewed and documented
	3061F Negative microalbuminuria test reviewed and documented
	3062F Positive macroalbuminuria test reviewed and documented
	3066F Documentation of treatment for nephropathy (e.g., dialysis,
	treatment for ESRD, CRF, ARF, renal insufficiency, visit to
	nephrologist)
	4010F ACE Inhibitor or ARB therapy prescribed or currently taken
Eye Exam (Retinal)	2022F Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by eye specialists
	documented and reviewed
	2024F 7 standard f eld stereoscopic photos with interpretation by eye
	specialist documented and reviewed
	2026F Eye imaging validated by match diagnosis from 7 standard f eld
	stereoscopic photos results documented and reviewed
	3072F Low risk for retinopathy (no evidence of retinopathy in prior year)
Medication Reconciliation	1111F Discharge medications reconciled with the current medication list
Post-Discharge (MRP)	in outpatient medical record
