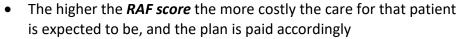

Medicare Risk Adjustment: Predicting Future Cost

- Medicare adjusts payments to advantage health plans based on the *health status* of its members
- The health status is determined by the conditions that are diagnosed during a face-to-face visit with a provider
- Certain acute and chronic conditions are assigned a risk adjustment factor (RAF) based on the predictive financial cost





RAF score: Resets Yearly

- A patient's RAF score depends on what conditions the patient has
- The RAF score relies on a complete assessment of all conditions and coding to the highest level of specificity
- All chronic conditions must be reassessed and documented every calendar year

Validation: Making it Very Clear

- Documentation must be clear to the reviewer and free of contradictions
- Document a chronic condition as active even if it is well controlled and the patient is asymptomatic
- Document a condition as historical once it has resolved or is no longer present
- Only bill for a condition if you clearly document that you monitored, assessed, evaluated or treated that condition on that date of service
- Do not diagnose a condition if you are trying to rule it out
